Sunday Morning Summary

Our Sunday school classes always provide a take home that tells you what we did in class. This gives you some information to start a conversation about. Ask them about the story, or reread it with them at home to reinforce what they are learning. When reading the story together, ask them to explain what it's about. This resource will also have any children's announcements on it, discussion questions and an activity you can do together during the week. Choose which pieces help the most in discipling your children.

Between Book

If you have a 4th-6th grader coming on a Sunday night, they'll receive a lesson book. This will have the lessons we are currently doing, as well as devotionals you can do with them at home. Please make time to do the devotionals with your kids, as you are their number one discipler. They will learn from you more than anyone. This resource is to facilitate both family devotional time and personal devotional time. It has journal space for them to use, and recommended bible readings.

The Bible App for Kids

Another resource we highly recommend is the FREE Bible App for Kids. This app can be put on any smart device, and functions like a high-tech bible story book. It will read Bible stories to your kids and allow them to interact with the pictures. It asks questions and functions like a game helping them learn the Bible. This is great for screen time, and can be used as a story book bible if you turn off the sound and read to your kids. Did we mention it's free? Check it out.
